POSITION SUMMARY: The primary function of this position is to supervise the lab operation, maintain Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments (CLIA) certification.

DUTIES:

- Oversee Laboratory Operations.
- Maintain Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments (CLIA).
- Obtain blood samples via venipuncture or fingerstick from and adult and pediatric patients.
- Ensure Lab assistant is compliant with all health, safety and CLIA standards.
- Test and calibrate equipment as needed.
- Perform CLIA waived testing and moderate complexity laboratory procedures.
- Monthly and annual water Total Coliform testing Proficiency testing for EPA.
- Maintain Laboratory Information System.
- Maintain Laboratory and Medical supplies/inventory.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Bachelor's Degree in chemical, physical, or biological science or medical technology.
- Minimum two years of laboratory training or experience.
- Possess a Nevada State Clinical Laboratory Technician
